Dear Saints of Redeemer,

Saint? Who? Me? Yes, you! Like Sts. Paul and Matthew, and Mary, Elizabeth, and Luke? Yep. That's right. You've "achieved" sainthood. St. Paul wrote to the Corinthians: "To the church of God that is in Corinth, to those sanctified in Christ Jesus, called to be saints together with all those who in every place call upon the name of our Lord Jesus Christ, both their Lord and ours: Grace to you and peace from God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ" (1 Cor 1.2-3).

The word hagios [ha-gee-os] translated as saint in the New Testament is the same word as holy. In fact, holy is the word's first definition in the Greek dictionary.

Your identity as a saint, a holy one, is found in Jesus who is the "Holy One of God" (Jn 6.69). Baptized into the Holy One's death and resurrection and grafted into the eternal life of the Holy Trinity, you have received holy status. You now "know that [Jesus is] in [His] Father, and you in [Jesus], and [He] in you" (Jn 14.20). Your identity as saint is found in Christ.

You were ransomed (bought back) with the Holy One of God's blood, which is "without blemish or spot" (1 Pet 1.19). The same blood washed you clean (Rv 7.14). In bloody water with the Word, Jesus prepares His Bride, and presents "the church to himself...without spot...that she might be holy and without blemish" (Eph 5.27). You are without sin in God's eyes! You are a saint! Notice, too, in the Corinthians and the Ephesians passages above, Paul uses the word church. He addresses the Corinthians as the "church of God," which is comprised of "saints together with all those who in every place call upon the name of our Lord Jesus Christ." Saints of God have their life and breath within a community – the Church. Thousands of miles may separate believers, but together in every place, they are the Church – the "body of Christ" (1 Cor 12.27). They are holy by divine calling; not by nature, and we credit our saintly membership in the Holy Community to the call of divine grace in Christ.

This is why Paul greets the Philippian Christians as "saints in Christ Jesus" (Php 1:1). Saints are individual members of the Church, but none lives to himself in the "communion of saints" (Apostles' Creed). There is no place for individualism in the Body of Christ. "Me, myself, and I" does not exist in the "one holy Christian and apostolic Church" (Nicene Creed). We are all saints; God's holy ones living together in unity in His holy Church; bound together by "one Lord, one faith, one baptism" (Eph 4.5). In this Church, saints are equipped for the "work of ministry" and "for building up the body of Christ" (Eph 4.12).

The opportunity is before the saints of Redeemer to extend a divine call to a pastor who is charged with equipping you for the work of the ministry as He delivers to you God's promises through Word and Sacrament. Another call meeting is in your near future. Approach this meeting with humility and thanksgiving by first recognizing that we have all sinned and fallen short of the glory of God (Rom 3.23). And then view your brothers and sisters in Christ as saints for whom Christ

died. This Gospel is what enables us to live together in unity as we love and be loved by one another; as we forgive and are forgiven by one another. Disagreements and differences will be among the people of God as we work toward a common goal, whatever the goal may be, but they cannot divide us from one another as saints in Christ Jesus. You've been redeemed by the blood of the Lamb, and you are together forever.

God's enduring peace to each of you, His saints, as we look to All Saints' Day (observed Nov. 5), and the festive months that lie ahead in the Church Year.

<u>Advent/Chrístmas Schedule</u>


- Midweek Advent Services will be on Wednesday December 6th, December 13th, and December 20th all at 6:00 PM.
