Who's Your Christian Mentor?

In a recent sermon, I spoke of the importance of having other Christians we want to emulate. Our Lutheran Confessions (bookofconcord.org) also speak to this in the Apology of the Augsburg Confession about the saints who've gone before us being examples for the Christian congregations to emulate today and help cultivate our members' character. "Our confession approves giving honor to the saints... The third honor is imitation: first of their faith, then of their other virtues, which people should imitate according to their callings." (Book of Concord, 238 (Apology 21, 6)


I have several mentors I look up to in addition to the Biblical examples to emulate. One of them is the great Lutheran theologian Johann Gerhard (1582-1637). When it comes to a pious man of God that I want to emulate, even though I never knew the guy personally, I can find that I want to emulate his Christian walk with the Lord in my own life, both devotionally and for others to follow in me as your Pastor and as a man of God for my wife, my children, and those in my community. In his book, *The Daily Exercise of Piety*, Gerhard exemplifies his desire to imitate Christ in four areas: First, he focuses on meditation and confessing his sins. From the seriousness of original sin to the daily lapse into sin to the severity of God's wrath against sin considered in the Passion and death of Christ, it's the right first step in examining our lives daily. Second is the contemplation of God's Divine gifts bestowed on us sinners. And our thanksgiving for them, including first our being formed and created by God in our mother's womb, to God preserving us, redeeming us, and giving thanks in all things for Jesus' Passion, calling us through the Word, and the forgiveness of our sins, to our Baptism into Christ, the thankful reception of the Lord's Supper, and Jesus guarding me from all evils, and the eternal promises of our salvation. Third is a focused meditation on prayer and our Christian life in sanctified, holy Christian living. We should follow many Christian virtues as we desire to walk with a heavenly perspective: mortification (killing) of the sinful flesh, the Old Adam, increase in faith, hope, love, humility, patience, gentleness, and chastity, as well as prayer for comfort in adversity and true peace of conscience, victory in temptation, and safekeeping from the plots of the devil.

And lastly, for fleeing or fighting against those worldly earthly sinful vices, namely, for the disdain of earthly things, denial of self, victory over the world, and prayer for a blessed end (to this life) and a blessed resurrection unto eternal life. Finally, the fourth focus to model and imitate is prayer for the neighbor as we desire to live out the second table of the law in Christ. Preservation of the Word of God and the increase of the Church through our witness. Prayer for pastors and those who heart the preaching, including ourselves. Prayer for our government and those in authority over us. Prayer for the household estate, relatives, and even our enemies and persecutors, as well as those suffering hardship and affliction.

I pray for you to find a good Christian mentor you desire to follow in addition to the most important example for our life and walk of faith, Jesus. A blessed and holy Passiontide and joyous celebration of our Lord Jesus' resurrection from the dead at Easter!
